- Reporting Scope 1, Scope 2, and **Scope 3** emissions
- **Resilience strategy / Scenario risk**
- Transition plan disclosure - "including information about offsets, target setting, and mitigation strategies... and progress towards these targets"¹

2. When will it impact me?



- From **1st July 2024** the Government will implement a roll out
- **Assess today** if your processes are prepared to measure and report all aspects in a time and cost-efficient manner

3. What are the consequences of inaction?



- Non-compliance is a **civil penalty**
- **Greenwashing regulations** will be strictly enforced
- Indirect consequences, including **damage to business reputation** and investment opportunities

- Identify and **address the gap** between your current reporting and what is mandatory
- **Automate** your data collection and reporting to minimise required labour
